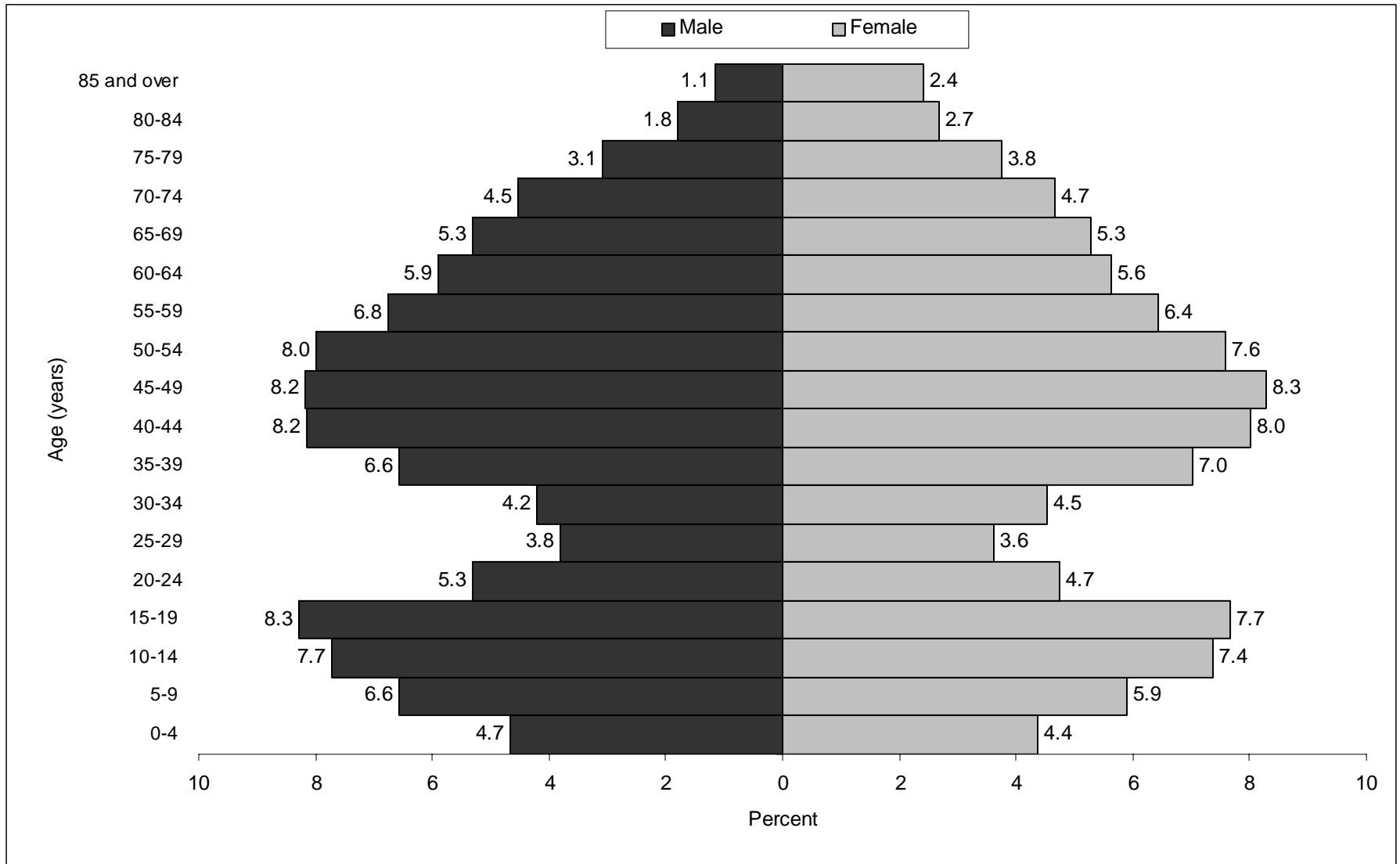

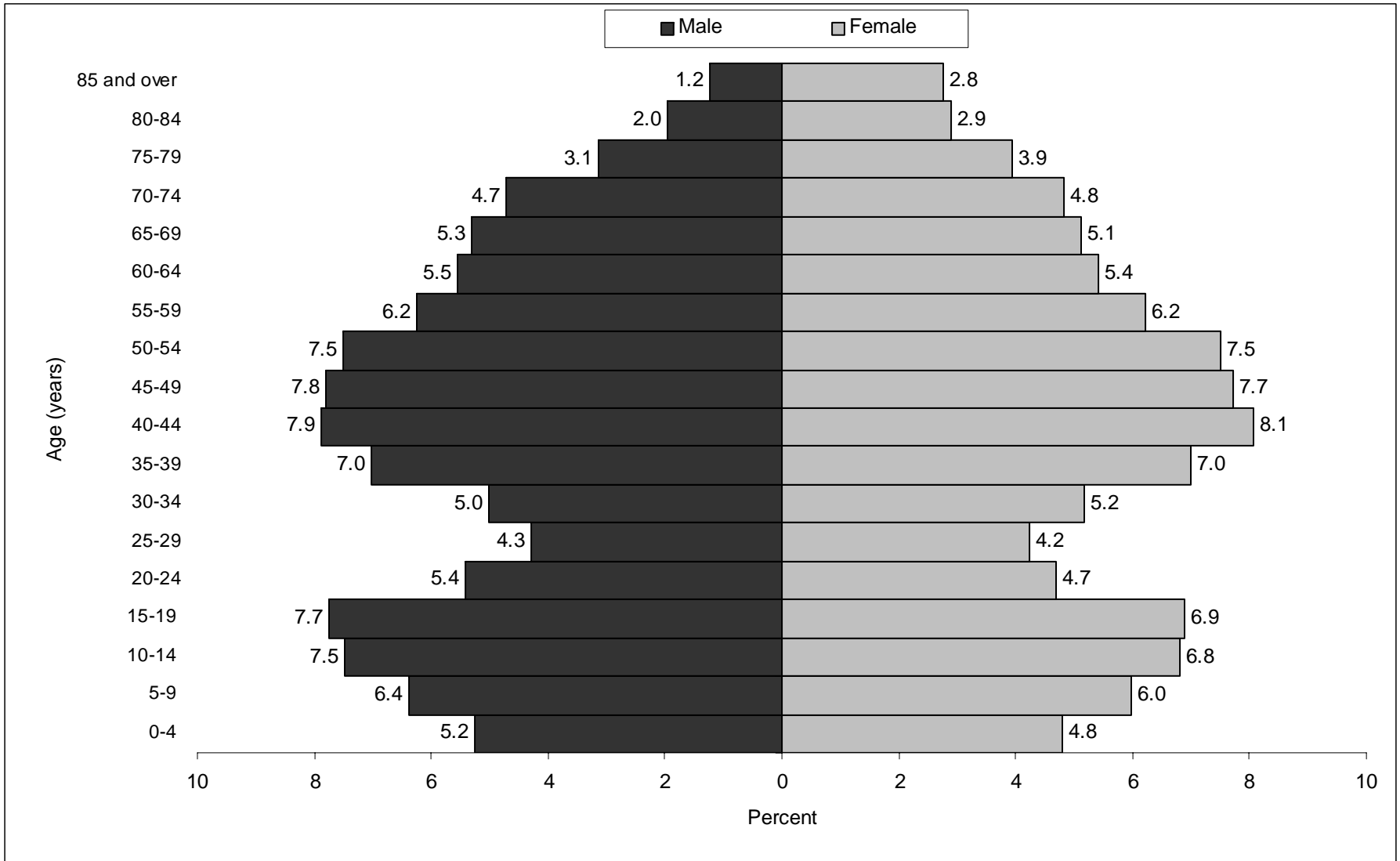

Appendix A Population Pyramid for Bruce County, 2001



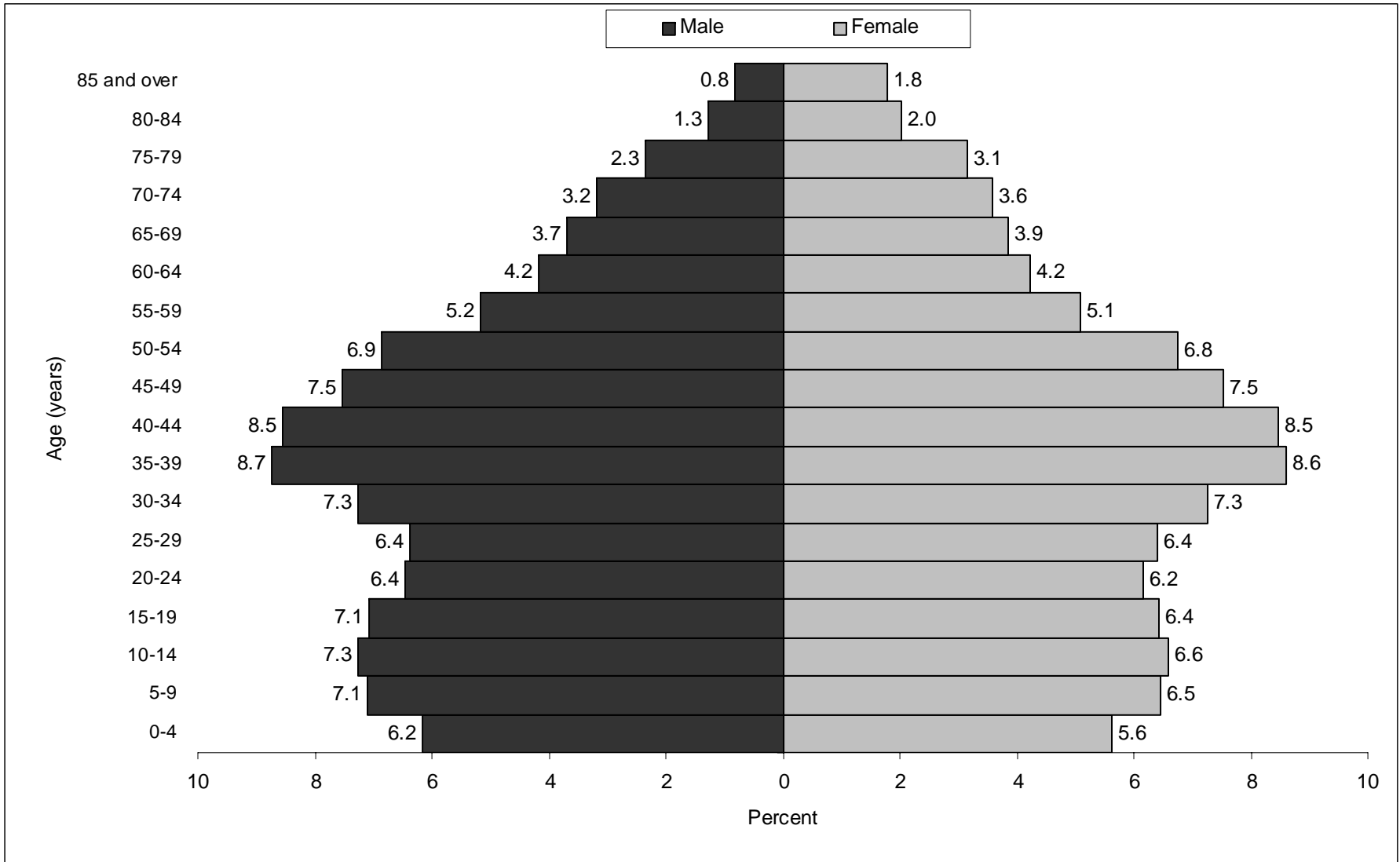

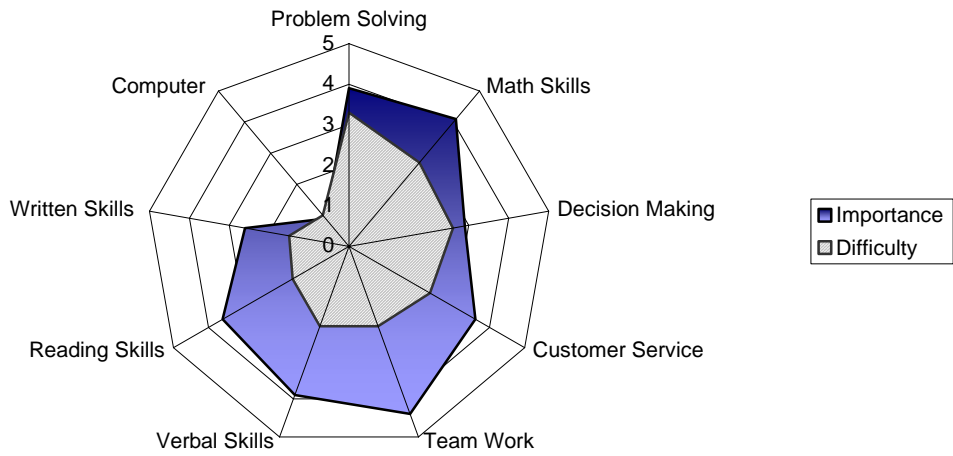
### Agriculture, Mining, Forestry Skill Analysis NAICS Code 1



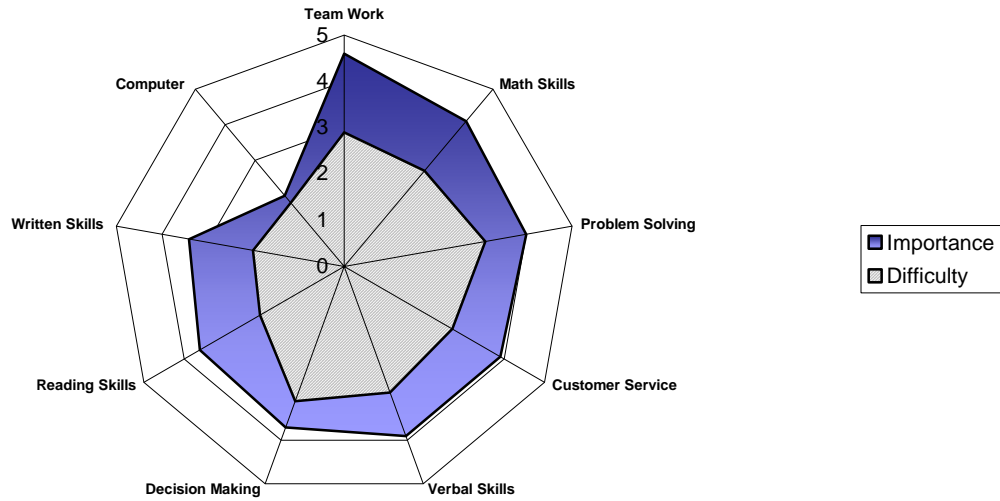

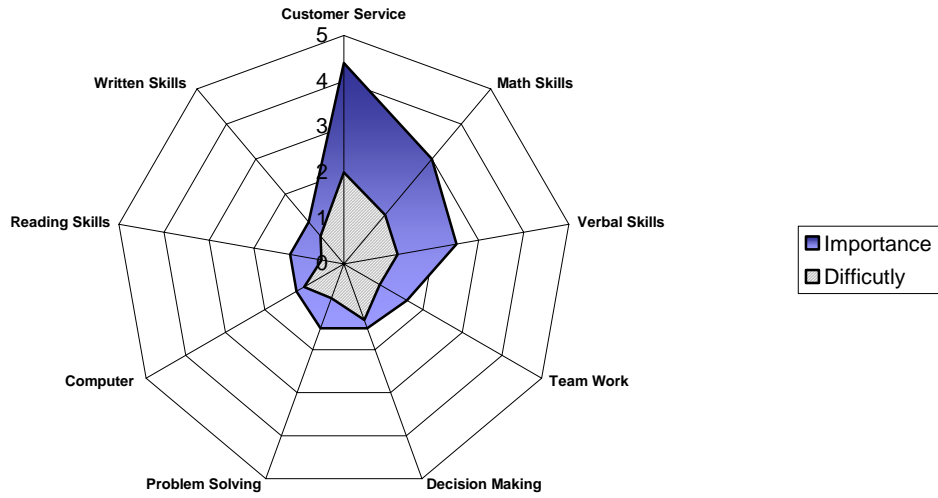
**Construction Skill Ranking

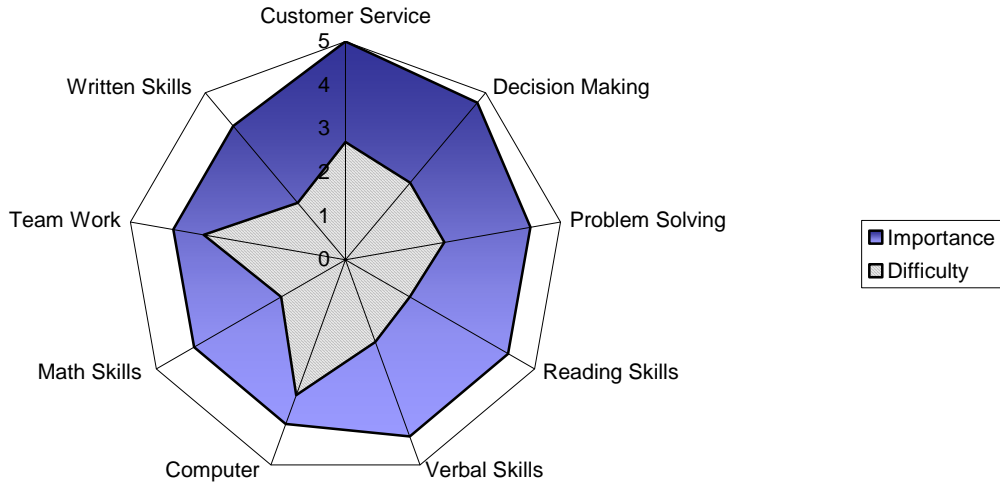
**Manufacturing Skill Analysis

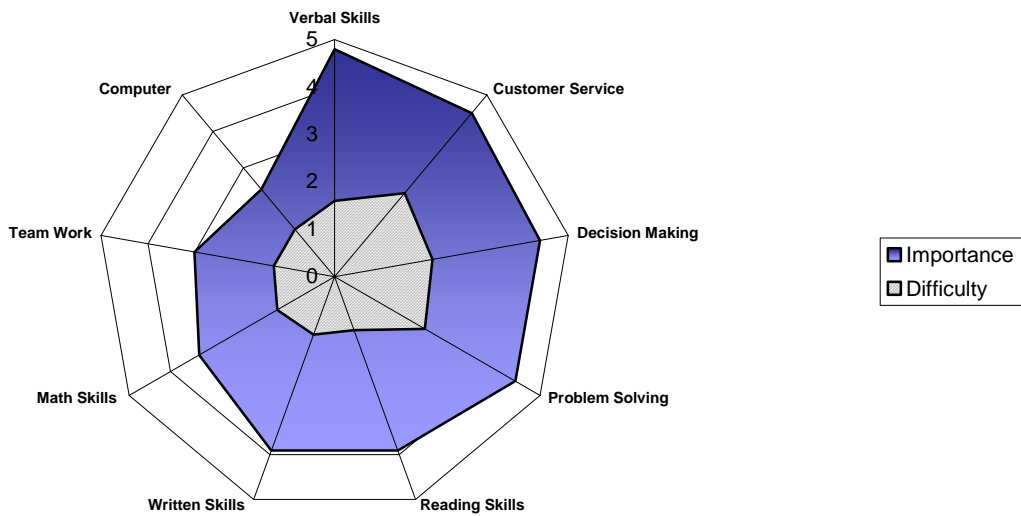
**Wholesale and Retail Trade Skill Analysis

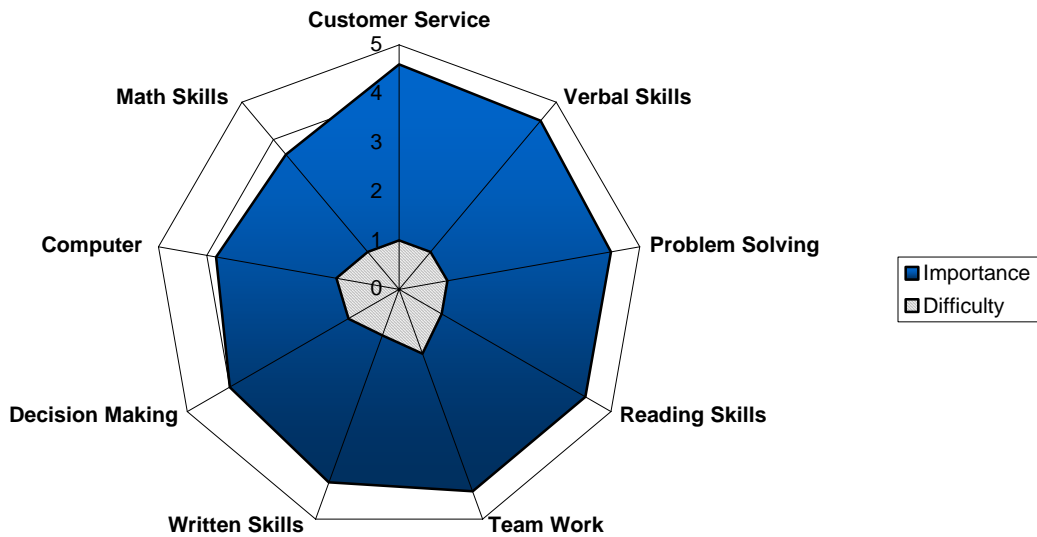
